The Deputy Chief just forwarded your request for information relating to someone living in the storage units at 1109 N Jackson off of 17th St. On 12-29-11 at approximately 23:00 hrs we received a call to that address on a domestic disturbance. We were busy with a call so IUPD responded to the address. They located a Benjamin J. Terhune w/m 01-30-88 and a Krystal Harden w/f 01-30-88 there in a fight. Mr Terhune advised that he is living in the storage unit part time and when he is not there he is at his parents at 7535 S Fairfax Rd, his cell phone number is 812-219-9322. The unit does not have a number but IUPD indicated it is the most southern building and is the 6th bay door from the east end of the building.

NARRATIVE
On 12-29-2011 at 2332 hrs I was dispatched to 1109 N Jackson Street in reference to a domestic dispute. Dispatch said the subjects involved were in a parking lot near the corner of 15th and Jackson. Officer Amandola and I arrived in the area and pulled into the parking lot of Bloomington Miniwarehouse storage facility. As we pulled in I observed a white male, later identified as Benjamin Terhune, on top of a white female on the ground, Krystal Harden. It appeared he was trying to hold her down. I exited my vehicle and told Benjamin to let her go

which he did. I handcuffed Benjamin and walked him back to my patrol car while Officer Amandola was checking on Krystal.

I read Benjamin his Miranda rights and he stated he understood. Benjamin said that he and Krystal had been in a relationship together and had broken up about 2 weeks ago. He continued saying that Krystal called him and wanted to come to the storage unit to get some of her property and he told her that was fine. When Benjamin arrived at the storage unit, Krystal was already there and had loaded some of his property into her car and was going to take it with her. He said they began to argue back and forth about the property. He said Krystal had found a pair of high heeled shoes and fishnet stockings belonging to his new girlfriend, Lucy Blackburn, while in the storage unit. He said Krystal stopped yelling, took the items and poured diesel fuel on them, then burned them in the parking lot. He then said she walked over to him and began hitting him in the face. Benjamin said Krystal had hit him 4 times total. He said he pushed her to get her away from him but she continued to hit him. He said he called the police while running from her. Benjamin said that she would not stop hitting him so he slapped Krystal and was holding her to the ground when I arrived. Benjamin had reddening of the skin on both sides of his face. Benjamin refused medical attention.

At this time I spoke to Krystal who stated she understood her Miranda rights after I read them to her. Krystal said she came to the storage unit to get money from Benjamin and to get her property. She said that she had loaded up what she thought was her property and was going to leave when Benjamin started arguing with her over what she was taking. She said she became very upset and decided to burn some items she had found that belonged to Lucy. She said after burning the clothing items she got into a physical fight with Benjamin punching him in the face. She said Benjamin slapped her back and wrestled her to the ground where he held her there until police arrived. Krystal had an abrasion on the left side of her forehead and a small cut to her right elbow.

IU BHAS arrived and checked Krystal, who refused medical attention. Krystal signed a medical waiver form that IU BHAS provided.

I then went to speak with Lucy. She said she saw Krystal burn her clothing items but did not want to get involved or make things worse. While Krystal and Benjamin were arguing and hitting each other she said she stayed out of the way. Lucy said she did not want to pursue charges against Krystal for burning her property.

After speaking to both Benjamin and Krystal, neither subject wanted to pursue charges for battery on the other. Krystal called her brother Bradley Givens, who came and picked her and her property up. Once Krystal had her property loaded up she left the area. Both were advised of disorderly conduct.
