- I. Approval of Minutes: Motion from Kerr and seconded by Dillard for approval of the minutes from the May 28, 2024, Motion passed unanimously.

- II. Personnel Update Current vacancies include 1 Social Worker, 3 Supervisors, and 12 dispatchers. We hope to hire 5-6 that would start in early August. There are currently 2 trainees who should be released around the first part of September.

- III. Committee Reports: None - no active committees.

- IV. Statistics: There was not much change from May to June. Fire calls were up slightly while police law calls actually declined slightly. Year-over-year stats continue to be below that of 2023 in phone calls and calls for service.

Compliance with protocols is showing that we are getting better and quicker and our times are well within the NENA standards.

- V. Old Business –

Stinesville Police Department does not have any active IDACS users as reported by IDACS Coordinator, Jarrod Bailey. They have to be in compliance with state law, which has not been accomplished. The MDT and IDACS policies have been

approved by the Town Board. When all approvals are obtained this Board will revisit the issue of dispatch services to Stinesville. We will address this at the next meeting in September.

VI. New Business:

Claims – motion made by Pedigo and seconded by Dillard to accept the claims as presented by City and County. Passed unanimously.

- VII. Police/Sheriff/Fire/EMS – Jeffrey Combs advised the Ambulance 22 with Monroe Fire Protection District went online this morning at 0800. The second ambulance is in reserve and a third will be coming later. They will respond to all structure fires. They will add additional staff and will be BLS only.

Kelly Mullis with IU Lifeline advised that they now have new districting that they're working with Eli on to get set up. They have new policies that she will send to Sarah and Karin.
